

# AETHUSA CYNAPIUM

La caratteristica più conosciuta e appariscente di Aethusa è la sensibilità al latte; un'intolleranza tanto forte da destare vive preoccupazioni. Il latte viene rigettato appena bevuto, è solitamente acido e cagliato in grossi pezzi, in altri casi assume un aspetto schiumoso. In generale è presente un aggravamento acuto da latte con vomito o diarrea, nel qual caso va posta diagnosi differenziale con Lac vaccinum defloratum, Natrum carbonicum e Silicea, associati a grande prostrazione e torpore. La disidratazione conseguente rende conto della debolezza e della sonnolenza di questi piccoli, il cui aspetto vecchieggiante con viso pallido, rugoso ed incavato testimonia la gravità della situazione.

Tipiche sono le labbra cerchiate da un pallore bianco-bluastro e la linea nasale che va dagli orifizi agli angoli della bocca.

Il bambino ha uno sguardo particolarmente ansioso e a tutti i sintomi si associa l'assenza di sete, che è il sintomo chiave del rimedio.

Nei bambini l'astenia può rendere difficoltosa la stazione eretta e la testa cade per il peso, sintomo che ha in comune solo con Abrotanum.

Il tratto gastro-intestinale e la conseguente cattiva assimilazione alimentare rappresentano dunque il punto debole dei piccoli Aethusa. Tra angosce e pianti, sono per solito sofferenti di gastroenteriti, diarree estive legate al tempo caldo e durante la dentizione. Le feci sono acquose e possono contenere muco verde o tracce di sangue, mentre l'addome si presenta gonfio e sensibile al tocco.

Dal punto di vista caratteriale si tratta, come Natrum muriaticum, di bambini riservati e sempre bene controllati, ma con forti emozioni interne.

Lo studio rappresenta un problema in quanto possono avere difficoltà di concentrazione, associata a disturbi da anticipazione. Hanno inoltre difficoltà ad apprendere e l'applicazione mentale è spesso causa di violenti mal di testa.

Gli animali li attraggono irresistibilmente, sono estremamente sensibili alla loro sofferenza e preferiscono la loro compagnia a quella delle persone; l'attaccamento agli animali è così spiccato che, nei momenti più critici, possono credere di vederne un'ampia varietà: di solito cani, gatti e topi; a volte, scambiano le persone presenti per animali.

Un altro capitolo importante riguarda le paure: di andare a dormire per il timore di non risvegliarsi, di chiudere gli occhi, dei medici. Al pari di Calcarea carbonica vede delle facce al momento della chiusura degli occhi.

Dal punto di vista fisico avremo sintomi gastrointestinali, soprattutto legati all'assunzione di latte. L'appetito è particolarmente marcato e tende ad aumentare anche dopo mangiato.

Può essere considerato un rimedio molto utile nella Sindrome di Louis Bar o atassia teleangiectasia, dove la componente fosforica ha sicuramente un'influenza sulle conseguenze da deficit di IgA (polmoniti, broncopolmoniti), mentre Alumina gioca un ruolo determinante nelle espressioni di incoordinazione.

## LYCOPODIUM CLAVATUM

Come nell'adulto, anche nel bambino Lycopodium possiamo distinguere due tipi costituzionali: un tipo più timido, caratterizzato dalla paura e dall'apprensione, e un tipo dittoriale e incline a mantenere il controllo su ciò che gli sta intorno (genitori, amici o situazioni).

Il primo tipo di bambino Lycopodium, in sala d'aspetto, è seduto vicino ai genitori e osserva ogni cosa che ha intorno, essendo questa per lui una situazione nuova; il secondo tipo può presentarsi, invece, come un bambino che alza la voce e continua ad importunare i genitori, vuole giocattoli, chiede di essere portato a casa perché non vuole stare nello studio del medico. Sono spesso bambini maleducati e viziati, parlano con tono di comando, si rivolgono in modo irritante ai genitori, che spesso rispondono debolmente; sembrerebbe quasi che sono i bambini e non gli adulti a controllare la situazione e questo mostra uno dei classici sintomi di Lycopodium e cioè forte con i deboli e debole con i forti ("Mind - Hard for inferiors and kind for superiors" / "Mente - Duro con gli inferiori e gentile con i superiori").

Nel primo tipo di bambino si nota, inoltre, una caratteristica mancanza di fiducia in sé, mentre nel secondo tipo troviamo una natura irritabile e un forte desiderio di potere.

La paura resta comunque una delle caratteristiche dei bambini Lycopodium; hanno ansia e paura quando sono soli, soprattutto al buio, e quando sono attorniati da estranei; questa paura si rivela anche nell'espressione del volto, imbronciato con le ciglia aggrottate.

In realtà queste due tipologie sono spesso una l'evoluzione dell'altra, nel senso che di solito Lycopodium ha maggiormente tratti psorici dominati dalla mancanza di fiducia in sé con un continuo tentativo di compensarla, dovuto al fatto che l'opinione degli altri è fondamentale. Nel corso del tempo, questo continuo bleffare porta ad una convinzione dei propri mezzi che sfocia nel caratteristico atteggiamento altezzoso del Lycopodium in fase siccotica.

Caratteristicamente i bambini Lycopodium mostrano paura e avversione per le situazioni nuove. Solo quando la situazione che si presenta loro è ben conosciuta diventano sicuri ed interagiscono normalmente con gli altri. Questa paura per situazioni nuove è strettamente collegata alla paura del fallimento, di non riuscire bene in quello che fanno e di apparire ridicoli in pubblico.

Hanno paura di alzarsi in mezzo alla classe e di fare un errore, così da apparire ridicoli; questo rivela il loro desiderio di essere il più bravo, "il primo della classe".

Possono soffrire di insonnia soprattutto in periodi in cui devono sostenere un esame, una prova o qualsiasi tipo di prestazione. Un periodo in cui possono essere ansiosi è quello che precede l'inizio della scuola; in questi periodi possono voler dormire con i genitori o con la luce accesa. Rimangono coperti e accoccolati sotto le lenzuola anche durante il periodo estivo quando fa caldo. Possono essere svegliati di notte da brutti sogni e non sapere dove sono. Dormono generalmente sul lato destro, come Phosphorus, o sull'addome.

Spesso il loro comportamento a casa è diverso da quello che hanno a scuola: a casa sono disubbidienti, mentre a scuola sono studenti modello, tanto da essere definiti "angeli a scuola, diavoli a casa". Non si permetterebbero mai di contraddirgli insegnanti, a meno che siano in quella fase in cui Lycopodium si sente molto sicuro di sé.

Sono vanitosi, preoccupati del loro aspetto, degli abiti che indossano e di come sono pettinati. Vogliono dominare, sono irritabili ed impazienti se non sono assecondati e diventano particolarmente critici; possono mostrare un grande desiderio di potere ed una grande irritabilità al punto da essere confusi con Nux Vomica.

Preferiscono giocare con bambini più piccoli in modo da poter prevalere senza problemi su di loro, oppure con quelli più grandi proprio per mostrare di essere superiori rispetto ai loro coetanei.

Spesso l'apprensione e l'ansia sono avvertite dai bambini Lycopodium a livello dello stomaco e dell'addome.

Fin da piccoli si svegliano spesso di cattivo umore e non vogliono parlare con nessuno; possono diventare ancor più scontrosi intorno alle quattro del pomeriggio, orario in cui Lycopodium in genere aggrava i propri sintomi.

I bambini Lycopodium, insieme ai Medorrhinum, sono tra i più predisposti alla dislessia; fanno errori nel leggere e nello scrivere, invertendo o dimenticando delle lettere.

Sono in genere irrequieti, incapaci di stare seduti fermi, toccano nervosamente ogni cosa. Hanno spesso le mani in bocca e umettano con la lingua le labbra, a volte fino ad irritarle. Lycopodium è notoriamente un rimedio con grande tropismo gastrointestinale, soprattutto epatico.

Nei neonati l'appetito può essere smisurato e urlano quando sono affamati.

Spesso hanno il singhiozzo dopo essere stati allattati; alcune mamme riferiscono di aver sentito, in utero, durante la gestazione, il loro piccolo Lycopodium avere il singhiozzo.

Un problema di questi neonati sono le coliche gassose, che li fa piangere e li rende inconsolabili finché non viene eliminato il gas in addome.

Nei bambini o negli adolescenti l'appetito può diventare vorace, soprattutto al pomeriggio, quando tornano da scuola, alla sera e possono svegliarsi di notte per la fame. A volte i genitori riferiscono che questi bambini mangiano troppo velocemente e non mastichano il cibo.

Soffrono spesso di stitichezza che si riscontra soprattutto in situazioni che generano in loro ansia, come nei bagni pubblici o quando vanno in vacanza in una casa non loro.

Per quanto riguarda i loro gusti alimentari, i dolci sono la cosa che desiderano maggiormente, amano molto il cioccolato che può dare però loro problemi, come dermatiti, mal di stomaco, mal di pancia e soprattutto stipsi. Possono avere coliche e meteorismo dai legumi, dal pane, dal formaggio, dalle cipolle, dai frutti di mare e da alcune verdure come i cavoli. Hanno in genere un miglioramento con le bevande calde e un aggravamento con quelle fredde: questo è applicabile non solo all'apparato gastrointestinale, ma anche al mal di gola e al mal di testa, di cui soffrono occasionalmente da bambini, mentre è comune negli adolescenti che saltano un pasto o lo fanno troppo tardi.

Come gli adulti, anche i bambini Lycopodium soffrono di ostruzione nasale e tirano su ripetutamente con il naso; tipico è il movimento ripetuto delle ali nasali.

Nel neonato può essere presente un persistente catarro nasale, con respirazione rumorosa e il bambino può respirare solo con la bocca aperta, cosa che lo obbliga ad interrompere la poppata. Sono suscettibili a raffreddori che spesso si complicano in bronchiti, bronchioliti e polmoniti.

Soffrono di tonsilliti ricorrenti, soprattutto a destra, con placche e ingrossamento delle ghiandole cervicali e dolore migliorato dall'assunzione di bevande calde.

Lycopodium è uno dei principali rimedi per il trattamento della mononucleosi quando è più colpita la parte destra della gola.

Il torcicollo è un problema che viene spesso risolto da questo rimedio, anche nell'adulto.

La prescrizione di Lycopodium deve essere presa in considerazione nel caso di dolori reumatici e artriti nell'infanzia, quando la parte più colpita è la destra. Possono riferire dolori brucianti migliorati dal calore, come in Arsenicum, e migliorati dal movimento, come in Rhus toxicodendron, Thuja e Pulsatilla.

Caratteristica è la colorazione giallastra dei denti.

Frequentemente si riscontrano ernia inguinale e criptorchidismo a destra.

Le bambine presentano un ritardo del menarca e riferiscono irritabilità, stitichezza e un grande desiderio di dolci nel periodo premestruale.

Un altro sintomo significativo che può essere notato nelle adolescenti, più che nelle donne adulte, è la pelle secca e screpolata sui talloni; la pelle può ulcerarsi con facilità, le eruzioni possono essere secche o umide e possono localizzarsi attorno alle labbra, alle ali del naso, dietro alle orecchie e agli organi genitali; le eruzioni possono anche trasudare un liquido acquoso e giallastro, simile a Graphites.

Molti bambini Lycopodium presentano verruche plantari, soprattutto a destra.

Tipico è lo sviluppo dei sintomi sul lato destro o che si spostano poi a sinistra.

Sono spesso bambini magri, freddolosi, amano stare al caldo, fare bagni caldi, anche se sono aggravati dall'esposizione al sole.

# STRYCHNINUM PURUM

La prima caratteristica generale di questo rimedio sta nell'intensità delle manifestazioni: i sintomi vengono espressi con forza e violenza; i sintomi sono forti e i pazienti li esprimono con forza.

In queste persone alberga un profondo risentimento ed un persistente senso di ingiustizia; si aspettano che qualcosa stia per succedere, ma nulla accade e quindi si sentono profondamente delusi.

Il risentimento include anche una sensazione di essere intrappolati, bloccati nel proprio destino, nella propria vita, senza possibilità di fuga. La disperazione e la convinzione di non aver possibilità di cambiare la loro situazione, crea un gran senso di scontentezza.

Questo lamentarsi che la vita è ingiusta è stato confermato anche in altri rimedi della famiglia delle Loganiaceae (Nux vomica e Ignatia).

L'irritabilità, anche se non così intensa come in Nux vomica, è tuttavia marcata e spesso diretta verso i membri della famiglia.

Possono quindi presentarsi con grandi ansie, fobie e paure.

In generale i disturbi di questo rimedio tendono ad essere episodici; si presentano in attacchi violenti; quindi le paure prendono la forma di episodici attacchi di panico.

Danno l'idea del tetano (che è una malattia tipica di Strychninum), o degli avvelenamenti; se infatti si leggono i provings, si nota che hanno periodi in cui la sintomatologia è assolutamente silente.

Paura di morire, della pazzia e di qualche malattia terribile; oltre a ciò paura del buio e di stare soli al buio.

L'attacco emerge da un substrato di, come dice il prover 128 di Allen, "estrema eccitabilità nervosa".

Cefalea; lateralità sinistra; dall'occipite, si estende sopra l'occhio sinistro; senso di compressione, pressione come un elmetto, come un cappello; è come in una morsa o come in una corazza ("Head - pain - pressing pain - armor; as if in").

Costrizione della gola; senso di soffocamento come se la gola fosse spremuta dall'esterno.

Dolori brucianti, crampiformi, spasmi alla bocca dello stomaco. Ansia nello stomaco. Allen scrive da uno dei suoi sperimentatori: "Una specie di fascicolazione interna e sensazione di nervosismo, che si irradia dalla bocca dello stomaco".
